Numbers and History

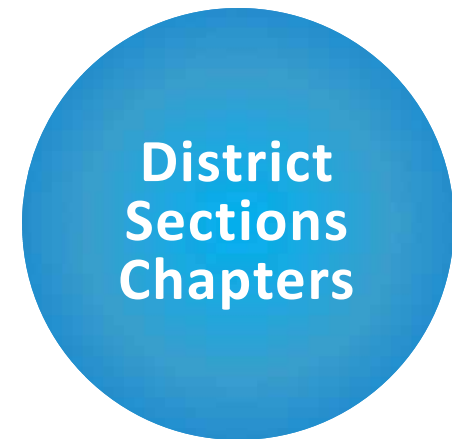
- ▶ Founded in 1930

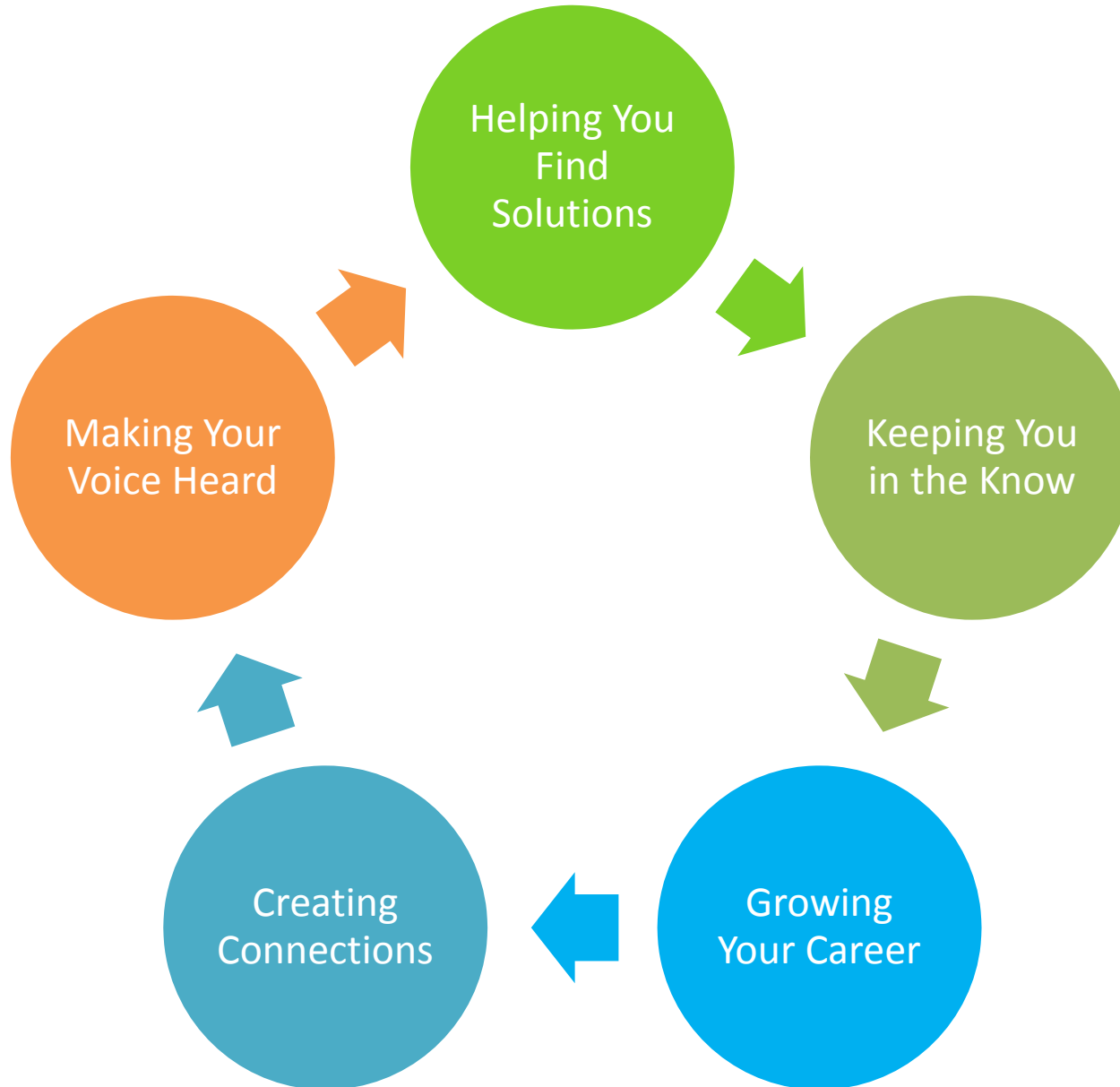

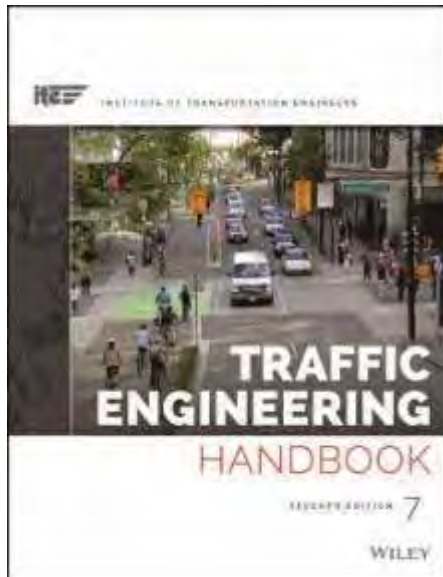

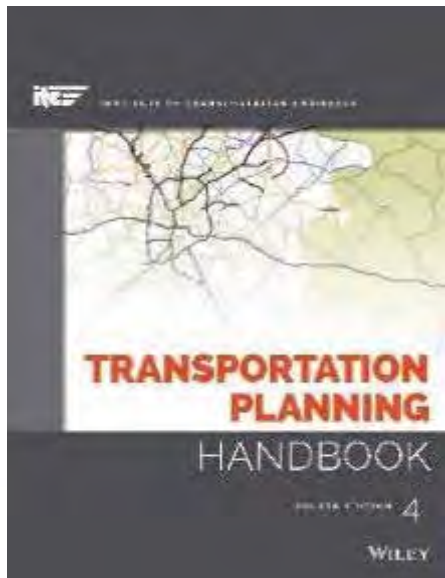
