Hi MCDITE,

I am writing to ask for your help with a study titled "Promoting Equitable AI in Transportation." We have gathered 230 responses so far (I have attached the survey results that we have got so far in case you are interested in the preliminary findings). We are hoping to get more responses."

Artificial intelligence (AI) is quickly changing transportation, but the equity and ethical impacts of AI are not yet well understood.
