

MASITE is proud to announce this one-time opportunity: The Registration Contest for the ITE International/District Annual Meeting (to be held July 21-24, 2024 in Philadelphia, PA). Are you a MASITE member under the age of 35 who has an interest in going to the ITE International/District Annual Meeting? Have you wondered what the difference is from an International Meeting to one of our local MASITE Annual Meetings? Then this is the contest for you!

Who May enter:

1. A MASITE member (age 21-35) in the year 2024.
2. Participates in MASITE-sponsored activities through attendance and/or volunteering of:
 - a. Western/Central/Eastern Area Meetings and/or,
 - b. MASITE Annual Meetings and/or,
 - c. District Annual Meetings and/or,
 - d. MASITE Committee and/or,
 - e. ITE Mid-Colonial District Committee.
3. Has preliminarily talked to their employer to obtain the time off work or is willing to use personal time off (PTO).

How much will it cost:

To attend the ITE International Meeting, the base cost is normally \$600 to \$1700 (or more) depending how far you are traveling. This year, the anticipated costs are:

- \$695-\$895 Early Bird Registration (by June 7, 2024)
- \$500-550 Hotel (if needed)
- \$150-175 Parking (if needed)
- \$695-1620 TOTAL

Costs will vary depending upon your proximity to downtown Philadelphia. MASITE will provide one \$1,000 stipend (MASITE Treasurer will send an expense report form) prior to Early-Bird registration closing. You do not have to register for the Annual Meeting prior to entering into the contest! There is no fee to enter the Contest.
